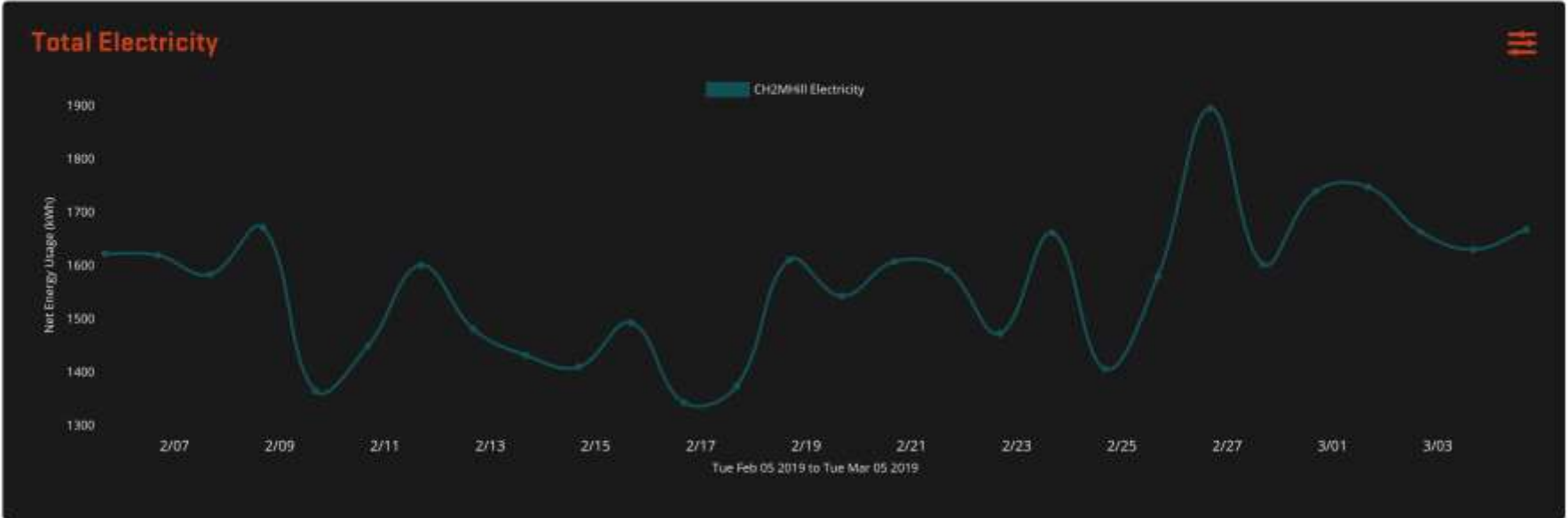

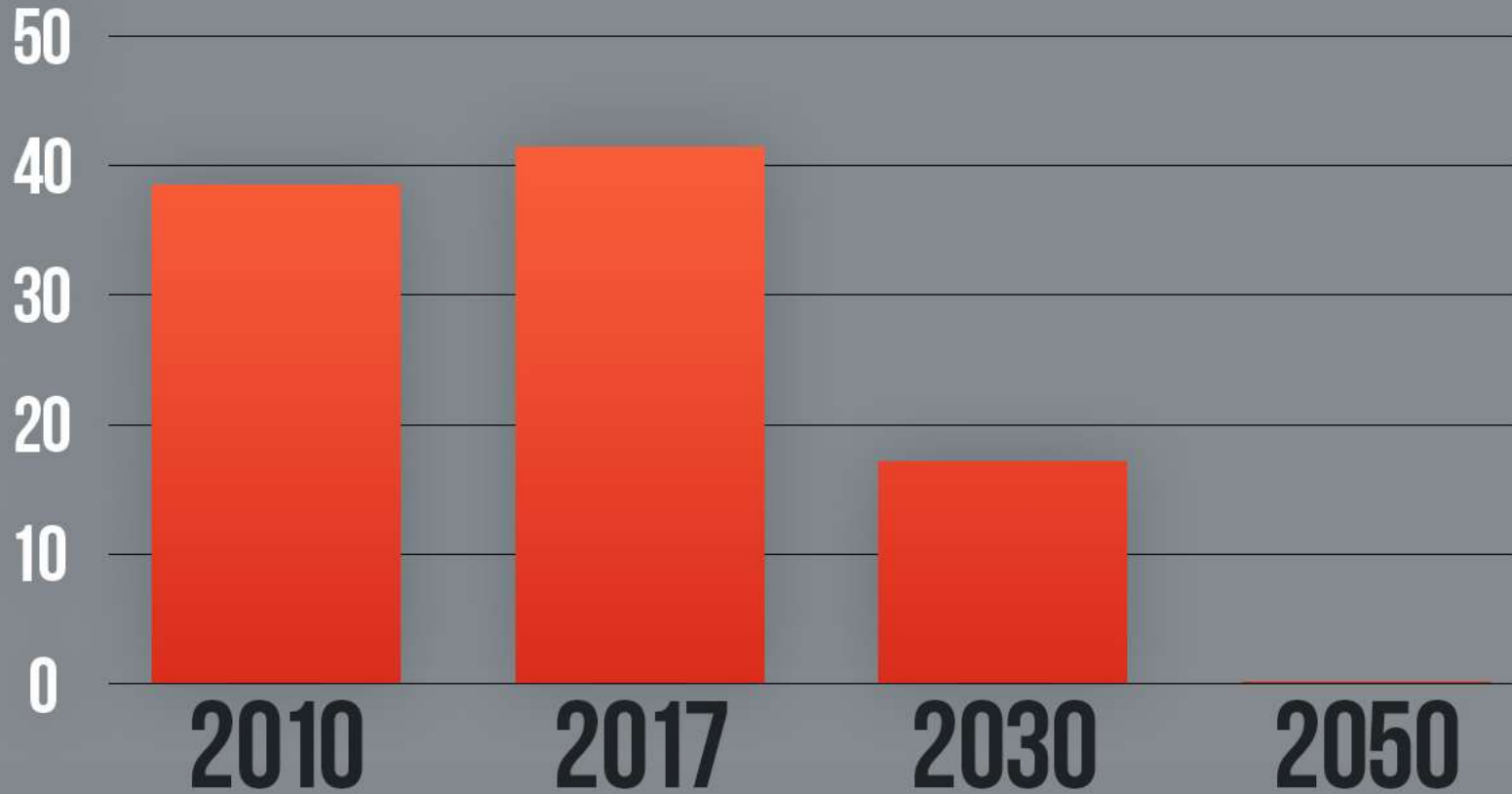

# BIG CHANGES NEEDED

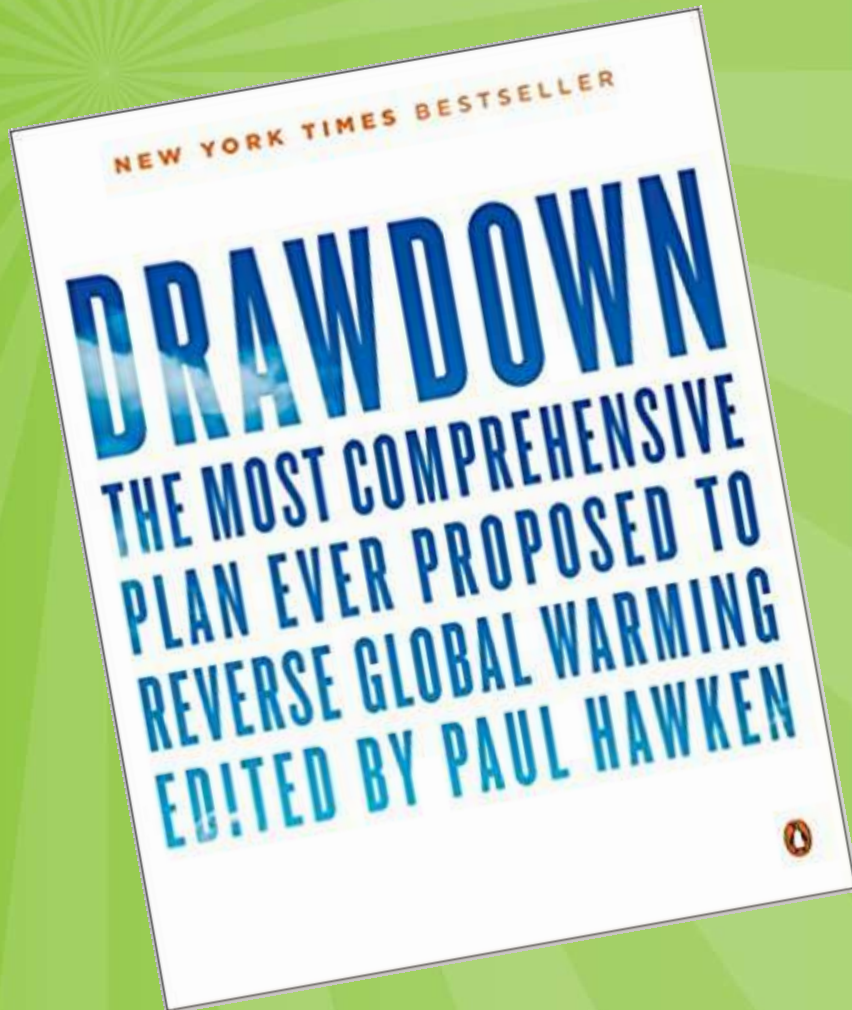
Limiting Global Warming to 1.5°C Will Require Deep Emissions Cuts

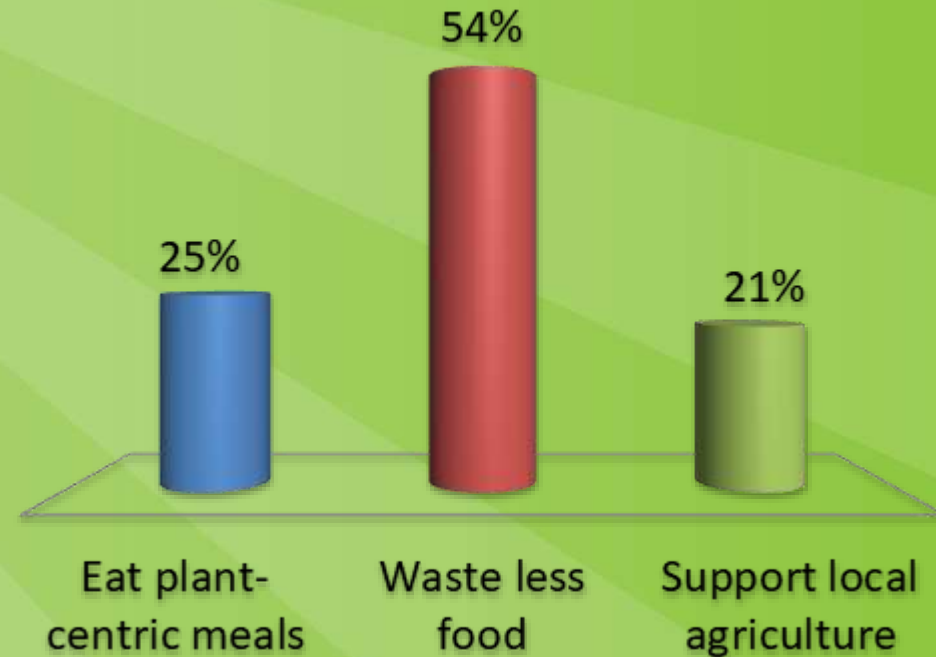

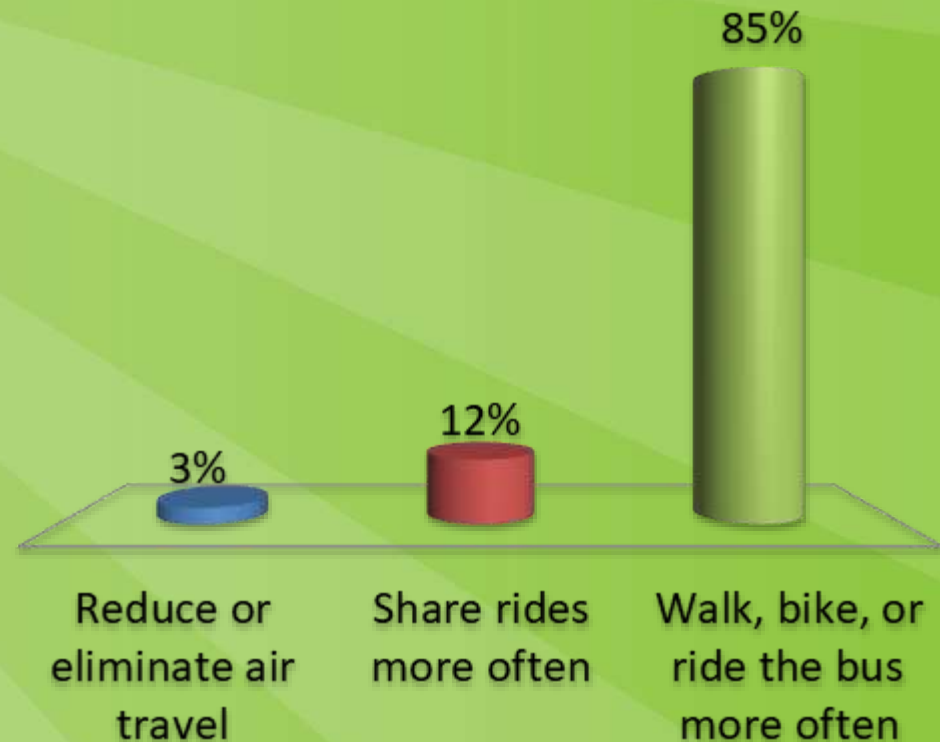

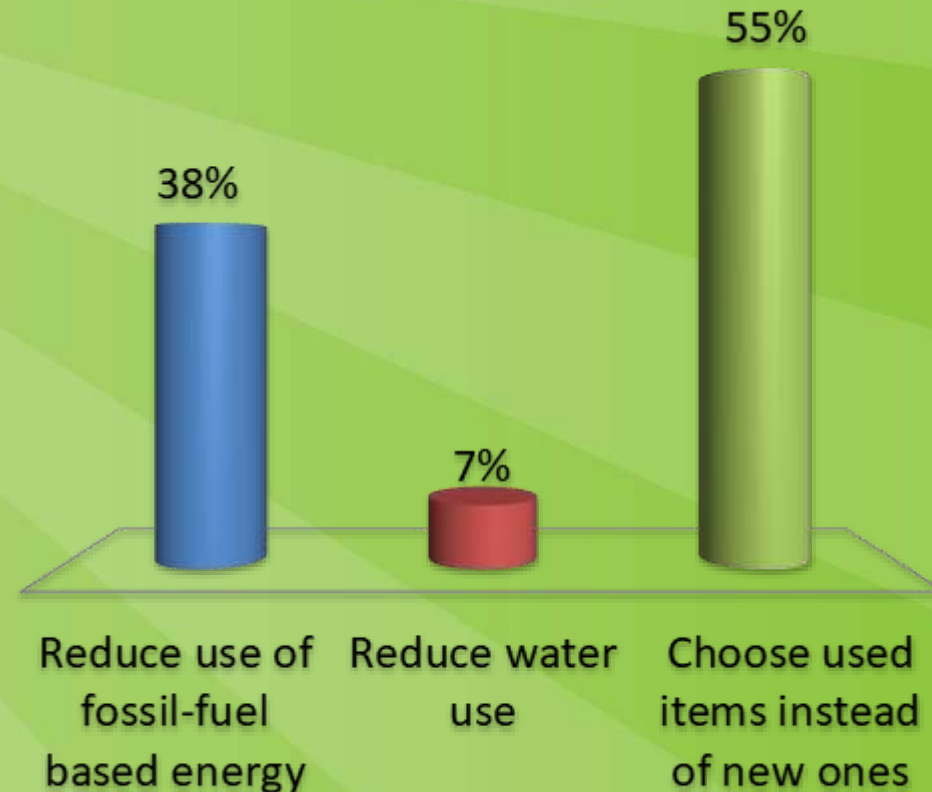
