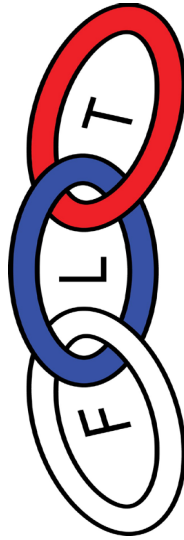

WASTE PREVENTION ACTION TEAM VISION:

CORVALLIS IS A WASTE-FREE COMMUNITY THAT FOSTERS BEHAVIORS TO REDUCE CONSUMPTION OF MATERIAL GOODS.

MAIN ACTION TEAM PROJECTS:

DON'T THROW GOOD STUFF AWAY!

Use this directory to find local places accepting items for reuse

ITEMS FOR LOCAL REUSE - WHERE TO TAKE? TURN PAGE!

APPLIANCES, LARGE (dishwashers, washer/dryers, stoves, fridges, etc.)

APPLIANCES, SMALL (microwaves, blenders, toasters, vacuums, space heaters, fans, etc.)

ART SUPPLIES

BEDDING / BATH (sheets/linens, blankets, comforters, towels, small rugs, etc.)

BIKES / EXERCISE / SPORTS / CAMPING (bikes/parts, helmets, skateboards, balls, backpacks, tents, etc.)

BOOKS (some places also accept magazines—call ahead and ask)

BROWN PAPER / LARGE SHOPPING BAGS (call ahead to see if accept tote bags)

BUILDING MATERIALS / HOME IMPROVEMENT (dimensional lumber, plumbing, electrical, paint, hand tools, power tools, doors, windows, lights, hardware, carpeting, etc.)

CDs, DVDs, LPs, VIDEO GAMES / SYSTEMS

CELL PHONES (preferably with chargers)

CHILDREN'S GOODS / CLOTHING (strollers, bike seats/trailers, baby gates, cribs, high chairs, playpens, diapers/diaper bags, accessories, toys, clothing, nursing items, maternity, etc.)

CLOTHING / ACCESSORIES

COMPUTER PAPER (ok if printed on one side)

COMPUTERS / MONITORS

EGG CARTONS (preferably with labels removed)

EYEGLASSES

FABRIC (material, batting, supplies)

FOOD CONTAINERS (clean glass / durable plastic w/lids)

FOOD - unopened, pre-expired (non-perishable canned and packaged food and beverages)

FOOD - surplus garden produce (freshly grown foods with no visible signs of spoilage)

FIREWOOD

GARDEN POTS

HOME ELECTRONICS (TVs, CD or DVD players, iPads/iPods, gaming consoles, stereos, cameras, alarm clocks, etc.)

HOUSEHOLD GOODS (luggage, utensils, dishes, cookware, cleaning supplies, lamps, decor, art, etc.)

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT / SUPPLIES (wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, canes, blood pressure monitors, shower chairs, adult diapers, glucose meters, hearing aids, hospital beds, reach-extenders/grabbers, etc.)

OFFICE EQUIPMENT (printers/scanners, faxes, calculators, telephones, headsets, etc.)

OFFICE SUPPLIES

PACKING MATERIALS, STYRO COOLERS / BOXES (clean foam peanuts, foam sheets, air pillows, bubble wrap, etc., and Styrofoam™ boxes or coolers—be sure to call ahead!)

PET SUPPLIES / FOOD

PRINTER CARTRIDGE REFILL / REFURBISHING

SCHOOL SUPPLIES (paper, pens, pencils, crayons, markers, backpacks, rulers, etc.)

TOILETRIES (shampoo, deodorant, lotions, shaving items, feminine products, travel-size items, etc.)

VEHICLES / PARTS (no "junkers" please)
